

4th Naxos Summer School: Language Variation and Change in Ancient and Medieval Europe

INFORMATION SHEET

Personal Property Damage or Injury

The summer school is not responsible for loss or damages to personal property by theft or other casualty, whether such losses occur in the classroom, public areas, or elsewhere. The summer school does not assume any liability for personal injury and every participant must take responsibility for their own safety. If you wish to protect yourself from the possibility of such losses or injury, you will need to secure an insurance policy that will meet your individual needs.

Refund

The summer school and workshop registration fee are not refundable. There is only the following option: should you decide to cancel your participation by May 31st, you should not pay a registration fee for a following Naxos summer school (on Language Variation and Change in Ancient and Medieval Europe).

Accommodation

Participants who will be staying at the municipality hostel are strictly liable for any damage to the allocated room or property caused by them. If you accidentally damage the room or if you see someone deliberately damaging any of the facilities, you are obliged to report it. It is also your responsibility to ensure that the rooms & communal areas are left clean and tidy at the end of your stay (you may be asked to pay 10 euros / per person / for the whole period to the hostel for cleaning your rooms).

Cancellation of a course
